

Mentor Mitakai Scholarship for International Students

Keio University is offering a scholarship made possible through the generosity of Mentor Mitakai, one of the alumni associations of Keio University. The Mentor Mitakai Scholarship for International Students is available for exceptional international students accepted by the Admissions for Overseas Students (GIGA Program).

This scholarship is awarded to hard-working students who display an aptitude for and interest in advanced information technology and policy, as well as those seeking to contribute to the global society using their acquired knowledge and skills at Keio.

Purpose of the Scholarship

The Mentor Mitakai Scholarship for International Students aims to support students who have excellent academic records, show a strong desire to pursue academics at the Faculty of Policy Management or Faculty of Environment and Information Studies at Keio University, as well as show a strong spirit of entrepreneurship, and are likely to contribute to the society in the future.

Number of spots available

Up to two students for Fall 2022 Enrollment

Amount Awarded

- Admissions Fee and Academic Fees for one year

The scholarship recipient will be exempt from payment of the admissions fee and academic fees for one year starting from September 2022.

Duration

The scholarship may be renewed for up to four years (undergraduate study only), subject to annual review.

Revocation of the scholarship

The scholarship will be revoked even during enrollment in the cases below;

- the applicant remains in the same year (repeating a year)
- the applicant receives extremely bad grades in class
- the applicant does not submit the necessary documents to the university (without any errors, incomplete or false information in the documents)

- the applicant does not promptly respond to contact from the university

Selection Method

Screening of application documents submitted for the Winter AO 2021 (Global) screening [Admissions for the GIGA Program].

Scholarship Renewal

Renewals of grants are considered in light of achievements from the previous year.

Scholarship students seeking a renewal must submit a renewal application, accompanied by a recipient report and transcripts for the current year by the deadline stipulated by the university; and attend a personal interview with members of the Scholarship Committee. Renewal procedures are announced in the summer of the following year.

Notification of Award

A Notification of Award will be sent out to the students selected as scholarship recipients via email from the Office of International Affairs in late March 2022. The scholarship recipient may be requested by the scholarship donor for attendance at related meetings or social events to the extent that they do not interfere with studies.
